

Collapse Containment Cheat Sheet

Prevent what breaks before it burns you



Most “fire drills” start long before the alert. This quick-reference sheet shows you where collapse begins and what to do before it becomes uncontainable.

Collapse Containment Signs and Solutions

Collapse Trigger	Early Warning Sign	Containment Move
Patch-loop reactivity	Roadmap gets hijacked by CVEs weekly	Pre-map asset fragility to define trigger bands
Misaligned stakeholder pressure	Firefighting used as “visibility”	Reset expectations using impact tolerance zones
Invisible failure tradeoffs	“Not my job” post-mortem after every incident	Reassign containment responsibility by function
Framework fatigue	Dashboard, traction disappears	Translate strategy into pre-approved behavior
Role confusion	Everyone’s responsible—yet no one actually is	Define “who holds what under pressure” clearly

ACT doesn’t eliminate failure. It **contains** it—before it owns you.
